Your Grace:

We would like to report to Your Grace and the Diocesan Council the results of the election of new officers of the Parish Council of our Church that took place at our annual Parish Assembly, held on Sunday, Feb. 2, 1964 at 1-4 p.m.

All elected are members in good standing of the St. Gregory the Illuminator Armenian Church.

Due to the fact that one of the diocesan delegates of our church, Hovhannes Tatoian moved to California a few months ago, the Parish Assembly elected Mr. Magar Nahabedian as the new delegate for a term of four years. The other diocesan delegate is Dr. Hrach Hitik, who has two more years to complete his term of office.

On this occasion we are happy to report to Your Grace, that the total cost of the construction of our new church building is anticipated to be \$ 150,000. Presently we have cash-on-hand \$ 30,000 and about \$ 20,000 pledges. As Your Grace knows the land has already been paid for.

In the name of the congregation of this Church we respectfully ask Your Grace and the Diocesan Council for a loan in the amount of \$ 10,000 to help us continue the construction of the building. The walls of the hall are already up and those of the church wait to be erected after the cornerstone-laying ceremony, to be conducted by Your Grace on Feb. 16, 1964.
