Dear Jack:

Last year I was very disappointed in the results of the Campaign for Stewardship, especially in our own Parish. We were assigned 25 or 30 stewards, that is five for each delegate to secure. But the Annual Report of the Parish Council for the year ending December 31, 1973<sup>n</sup> showed that there were only seven stewardships from the St. James Parish, six of which were secured by me and only one by the other four delegates.

With such a poor showing, should that be the general average within the Diocese, the project cannot possibly succeed and the contributions made by a handful of us will fail to meet the need.

Even though I am semi-retired and my income has been drastically reduced, I will honor my pledge, if and when I am assured that the stewardship project is being tangibly supported by most of the delegates of the diocese.

I hope you will understand my attitude and share my concern.
