Earlier this year, I submitted a brief outline describing departmental goals, ideas, movements, etc. It ~~would~~ have been productive had we had the time and luxury of discussing these goals at length. However, I hope that we may do this sometime early next ~~years~~.

As you can see on the attached schedule containing a month by month breakdown of the expenses incurred by my department, we were able to maintain as much work, as well as do more this past year while keeping well under our budget. This is mainly due to the fact that we are able to have things done for free, or, receive various needed items as donations, etc., etc. It is certain that we cannot "figure" these in when considering a budget request. At best, we can hope that the situation may continue, whereby I may not have to pay for every item used in running the office and maintaining the administrative operation on a day to day basis.

During this next year, we are planning to step up our parish visitations, as well as increase contact and be more in touch with the Chapter Chairmen and other potential leaders. This effort will be augmented by more printed matter being sent to the Chapters, as well as the members (and non-members) themselves.

Therefore, ~~we~~ request this year is \$9,000.00. This does not reflect the items briefly mentioned on the "goals ~~outlined~~" mentioned above, as those items require a different approach and strategy. I shall be in New York City in January for the ACYOA Central Council meeting, Jan. 14-16, and plan to stay extra if we can find the time to meet and discuss pertinent matters.
