PROPOSAL FOR AMENDMENT TO WOMEN'S GUILD CENTRAL COUNCIL BYLAWS FROM WOMEN'S GUILD OF ST. THOMAS ARMENIAN CHURCH, TENAFLY, NJ

### Article 9 Section 36

#### Currently:

Any dues-paying Women's Guild member in good standing for six months, and is also a dues-paying member of the parish, is eligible to be a candidate for delegate to the Women's Guild Assembly.

### Proposed:

Any dues-paying Women's Guild member in good standing for one year who is also a dues-paying member of the parish is eligible to be a candidate for delegate to the Women's Guild Assembly.

#### Rationale:

Per Article IX, Section 2, of the Women's Guild Bylaws, it is required to be a Women's Guild member for one year before you can be elected to the Executive Committee. To be consistent, and to permit time to become familiar with Guild procedures, the time requirement of membership should be one year for delegate, also.
