RE: 1990 Armenian Studies/Service Program

DATE: February 27, 1990

For the 1990 Armenian Studies Program (ASP), I propose the following plan:

Under the auspices of His Holiness, Vasken I, the ACYOA will study for two weeks in Yerevan as it has done for the traditional ASP. During the second two week period, the group would make daily trips from Yerevan to a different village in the earthquake zone. The group would take with them: relief supplies; religious books such as Bibles, Badarak Books, Diocesan Curriculum, which have been translated into Armenian; Health, "How To", and other books; etc. We would need a bus and truck each day. The materials would have to be gathered now, shipped to Yerevan, and stored in a warehouse. Our itinerary would have to be planned in advance, so that the village would expect us, and we could prepare our group.

I would suggest that we send a representative to Armenia in March to make the arrangements in advance. I would like to go, with Ared, who could then help me with the language, but it does not have to be me.

On behalf of the ACYOA, would you make this proposal to Srpazan Hayr so that upon his approval as I have proposed or with his changes, he could make the appropriate request to Vehapar.
