Transfers and baggage-group transfer by motor-coach service to and from airports. Portage is limited to two average size suitcases [44 lbs. to Armenia; 70 lbs. to Jerusalem] per person. In addition, each passenger may bring an overnight or flight bag which may be carried on the plane. Most gratuities are included.

Tour rates do not include: cost of passport, airport departure tax [Jerusalem], excess baggage charges or insurance. Meals will vary with each of the three tours. A separate itinerary for each tour will be forwarded with applications. Space is limited.

Educational Tour to Armenia

Four Weeks in duration.

Visit Armenia as guests of His Holiness, Vazken I, Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians.

See the many points of interest such as: Ancient churches and monasteries, monuments, historic sites, archaeological diggings, museums, galleries, the beautiful countryside and the magnificent metropolis of Yerevan, the capital city.

Experience many cultural, athletic and social activities, such as: The opera, symphony, ballet, and soccer games, as well as the Olympic training center and night-life in Yerevan.

See Armenia's industry: The motion picture studios, the cognac factory, the automobile factory, the winery, art and crafts workshops and the restoration of ancient cathedrals and sites.

Visit Armenia's schools and universities, including the University of Yerevan, the Conservatory of Music, the Children's Summer Camps and student outing centers.

Participate in dance, language and music instruction.

Meet with professionals in your field of interest on an informal basis and exchange ideas and new concepts

Experience Divine Liturgy at the Mother Cathedral of Holy Etchmiadzin, and an audience with His Holiness, the Catholicos.

Tours to the Art Galleries, Museums, Opera House, Manuscripts Library and more.

See the Monastery of Keghard, the churches of Sts. Hripsime', Gayane' and Shoghagat. Visit Kor Virap, Sardarabad, and Erebuni - the 2750 year old archaeological discovery of the first settlement of the city of Yerevan.

Meet the people, in the market-places, downtown, at work and play, in the parks, the towns, resorts and their homes.

Shopping sprees and night-life in the exciting metropolis of Yerevan, Armenia's growing capital city.

Special tour to Holy Etchmiadzin, the Holy See of the Armenian Church.



Program (3).....

Jerusalem - "The Holy City"

Two - Three weeks in duration.

Excursions to the Biblical sites: Jericho, Capernaum, Bethlehem, Nazareth, Jordan River, Dead Sea, Mt. of Ascension, Gethsemane, Solomon's Pools, and many others.

Experience the Holy Places of Christendom, such as: The Holy Sepulchre and sites of the Crucifixion - the crowning of thorns, the stone of flagellation, finding of the Holy Cross, witnessing to the Holy Mother of God, place of the Crucifixion, and the Tomb of Christ.

Visit the Cathedral of the Holy Nativity, Pilate's Palace, Herod's Palace, Mt. Zion and more

Tours of Armenian Jerusalem: The Cathedral and Monastery of Sts. James, the Convent of the Holy Archangels, the Monastery of the Holy Saviour, the Manuscripts Library and Church of St. Theodoros, the Seminary, the Gulbenkian Armenological Library, the parochial school of the Holy Translators, the Printing Press, the Religious Art Museum, the Patriarchal Palace and other parts of the vast Armenian complex in the Holy Land.

Orientation sessions for tours of the Holy Places. Optional discussion and class periods on Armenian religious subjects and the Biblical Lands.

Shopping sprees in the colorful bazaars of the ancient city of Jerusalem.

Included in this trip is a 3 day tour to the fascinating city of Cairo, Egypt. See the pyramids, the famous museums and more.
