Dear Srbazan Hayr,

I write to you in regard to the Armenian Museum; as my primary role here is to oversee Cultural Affairs, this is a matter of no small concern to me. Ruth Thomason asked me to accompany her to a meeting today with Fr. Khajag on the Museum, and I expect that the Reverend Father will speak to you shortly about what transpired. Essentially, the main points are as follows: 1. The Museum requires a Director, in part- or full-time capacity, to arrange properly for the care of acquisitions, fund raising, publicity and arrangement of new exhibitions, and the photographing of all exhibits. 2. The rare books in the Library collections and the Manuscripts in the Treasury are in particular need of careful attention. 3. Appointing a Board of Directors for the Museum to publicize and increase its activities so that members of the community will donate their rare possessions with confidence that they will be catalogued and handled with professional care and responsibility.

Ms. Thomason feels confident of her ability to undertake the various commitments outlined above, and should appreciate the opportunity of discussing the matter at a time convenient to you.
