JUDGMENT OF ABSOLUTE DIVORCE

This case having been brought on to be heard upon the
Complaint filed herein, said Complaint having been amended to

I.

MARITAL HOME

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the marital home located at 2416 North Wilson, Royal Oak, Michigan, more fully described as follows:

South 32 feet of Lot 215 and North 16 feet of Lot 216, Red Run Golf Subdivision of the East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 10 and part of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 10 and part of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 15, Town 1 North, Range 11 East, City of Royal Oak and Royal Oak Township, Oakland County, Michigan, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Liber 30 of Plats, Page 41, Oakland County Records,

is awarded to the Plaintiff, Rose Klavanian Smith, free and clear of any rights or claims thereto by Defendant, Robert E. Smith, Sr. A copy of this Order of Divorce may be filed with the Oakland County Register of Deeds to effectuate transfer thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Rose Klavanian Smith, Plaintiff, shall assume the mortgage payments on the above described premises and shall hold the Defendant, Robert E. Smith, Sr., harmless from any liabilities thereon.

II.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that each party is awarded that personal property presently in their respective possessions, free and clear of any and all claims thereto by the other, with the following exceptions:

A. Defendant is awarded the heater which was in the garage of the parties on October 1, 1975.

B. Defendant is awarded the air-conditioner which was in the marital home of the parties as of October 1, 1975.

C. Defendant is awarded any books and papers given to him by his father which are in the possession of the Plaintiff.

III.

ALIMONY

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that both parties are forever barred from any claim of alimony from the other.

IV.

INSURANCE PROVISION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that any rights of either party in any policy or contract of life, endowment or annuity insurance of the other, as beneficiary are hereby extinguished unless specifically preserved by this Judgment.

V.

DOWER RIGHTS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that upon the receipt of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar Plaintiff does hereby release all of her dower rights in the lands of Defendant other than those mentioned herein, and she shall hereafter cease to have any right in said lands acquired by Defendant.

VI.

ALIMONY ARREARAGE

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Plaintiff shall be forever barred from claiming any compensation of whatsoever kind for arrearage of alimony that was heretofore entered by this Court.
