Dear Father Terenig:

This is to confirm our telephone conversation of Monday May 27, 1985, in which we agreed that you will with the final approval of our Primate Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, become the spiritual leader of the Armenian Community in the State of Ohio, as the pastor of the St. Gregory of Narek Armenian Church of Cleveland, at 666 Richmond Road, Richmond Heights, Ohio 44143.

Our agreement includes a financial package schedule as follows:

Basic Stipends	\$15,120.00
Additional increments (3)	3,240.00
Parish owned car allowance	1,700.00
Housing allowance	6,432.00
Clergy Medical Insurance	3,912.00
Clergy Pension	1,000.00
Parish supplement for contingencies	1,596.00

Annual \$33,000.00

We further agreed that in December, 1985, the Parish Council would review finances and make required adjustments.

Attached for reference is the Diocesan adjusted clergy stipends schedule, effective January 1, 1985.

If this agrees with your thinking, please sign your name on all three (3) papers and return one (1) original and one (1) copy of same to me by express mail please.

I must have a signed copy of our agreement in the hands of our Primate, Archbishop Torkom Manoogian by June 10, 1985, please.


Again the final \$33,000.00 figure is all inclusive which includes your basic stipend, three (3) increments, housing allowance, Clergy Medical Insurance, Clergy Pension, Parish owned car with the per mile allowances which also includes the entire operating cost of the automobile, including insurance. Plus the Parish supplement for contingencies.



including gasoline, oil, repairs and
insurance.

HOUSING ALLOWANCE

Parish owned home All costs including utilities.

Rental If parish does not own a home, it will
provide an allowance for housing
including utilities...\$536.00 monthly.

Home owned by Pastor Pastors may use housing allowance for
rental or payments on house purchase.

Full payment
