It brought to mind a similar situation in San Antonio, Texas. They were there for an Air Force Reunion in September 1988 and stayed at the Winger Hotel which is next to the Alamo. They had recently opened the Rivercenter which had Lord & Taylors and Dillards and more than 135 specialty shops - three levels. A really beautiful place.

Parking was in Rivercenter garages on two streets on each side of the center. Two hours free - no purchase necessary. Have the parking ticket validated at any Rivercenter store.

Our group was having a memorial service at St Joseph's Church. We were told to walk around the corner of Hillards and down a couple hundred feet to the church. Knowing that Hillards was next to the Menger and that the Rivercenter wrapped around it we wondered.
