We are sorry that our previous letter was found unsatisfactory by the Diocesan Council, concerning our request for the assignment of Fr. Haigazoun to our parish. We were unaware of any such directive that all communications to you were to be made on official Parish stationery or that both the secretary and the parish council chairman are supposed to sign letters. Perhaps, if there is such a stringent requirement, it might be wise to send out a directive from the Diocesan Council to the entire Diocese so that this policy would be clear to all involved.

In accordance to your verbal wishes to me during the recent conversation we had, we are resubmitting our request to you. At a special parish council meeting on 8/13/83, the parish council of the Holy Trinity Armenian Church of Cheltenham voted to invite the Very Rev. Fr. Haigazoun Melkonian as our pastor. We therefore are requesting that as the Primate of our Diocese, you assign Fr. Haigazoun to our parish, naturally with the approval of the Diocesan Council.

Fr. Haigazoun and representatives from our parish council and Diocesan delegates have already met and discussed the problems and future goals of our parish, and have come up with a mutually agreeable stipend which we previously have sent to you, and which is in accordance to the Diocesan Clergy Stipend Committee guidelines. We feel that December 1983 would be a convenient time for a transfer.

We hope that you and the Diocesan Council would address this issue as soon as is possible as undue time has unfortunately been lost and we are anxiously awaiting to work with Fr. Haigazoun in serving our Lord in His mission.
