A Brief Pastoral Report and a Message

For the Year of 1972

Dear Parishioners,

With the grace of God another year is completed in the life of our Church. The reports of our various church auxiliary organizations will tell you about the measure of accomplishments realized during the year of 1972.

With the year of 1972 I was completing my 15th year of service of the Great Metropolitan Armenian Church of St. John's of Detroit, Michigan when by September I was appointed by the Diocesan Primate Archbishop Torkom Manoogian as the Pastor of St. Gregory of Narek Armenian Church of Cleveland, replacing Father Arshag Vartabed Khatchadourian, who was Pastor of this church for the last five years. Father Arshag, after a farewell dinner given in his honor (September 5) and his farewell liturgy (September 10), was already transferred to South Milwaukee, Wisconsin to be the Pastor of the Armenian Church there.

Unfortunately, it was not possible for me to assume my duties immediately after Father Arshag vacated his position here. Officially I assumed the responsibility of my pastoral office beginning with Sunday, October 29th. However, I was able to pay two visits to Cleveland before this date, with overnight stay, to celebrate the Divine Liturgy. On the major feast of Holy Cross I came to celebrate the Divine Liturgy, preached in both languages (Armenian and English), and performed the special ceremony of festive Antasdan, which is only performed once a year on the feast of the Exaltation of Holy Cross (September 17). My second visit was in early October which coincided with the 17th Anniversary of Enthronement of our Catholicos. Again, I celebrated the Divine Liturgy, gave the sermon in both languages and performed the special ceremony of prayer service for the pontiff in honor of our Vehapar on October 8th; actual date October 2. By this time I've concluded my first three months service with the inclusion of January, 1973.

The pastoral report for the year of 1972 comprising of the year's activities and also my three months activities have already been prepared on an extensive basis and will be a part of an Annual Report Booklet of 1972 and will be kept in our church files as historical records with this Annual Report Booklet.

This is a brief report only and, of course, we cannot go into any detail. However, I may expend my remarks in my oral report to the congregation.

For the present time, therefore, I would like to include in my brief pastoral report in a general way that the Divine Liturgy is being conducted and sermons are being delivered without interruption; the special church ceremonies are being observed properly according to the requirements of seasons and feasts of the church; counselling is being extended; conferences are being scheduled for marriages; sick calls are being made at hospitals and homes; pastoral visitations are given on regular basis; presently on the occasion of the Holy Theophany season home blessing is being done. During my first three months period, two funerals were conducted (Nov. 20, 1972 and Jan. 10, 1973).

The administrative work of the church is carried by the pastor and Parish Council Chairman, Mr. Jack Hachelian. The church office work is carried by voluntary help for typing, stenciling and mimeographing, etc.

Our future projects on which we will concentrate and give our utmost attention includes particularly the publication of the "Paros", making it more efficient; our Choir which needs to be strengthened with a qualified Choir Director and an organist; a Bible discussion session for interested people will be resumed shortly; and the renovation and furnishing of the parish house, both pastor's living quarters on the second floor and pastor's study, lounge, library, and workshop on the first floor. A master plan has been already prepared and parish council during the year of 1973 should start some of the most important phases according to the priorities.

As we embark into the 9th year of our existence in Richmond Heights, may God pour his blessings upon this community and may St. Gregory of Narek Church continue her mission of living Armenian Christianity with vigor and apostolic zeal.

The pastor extends his heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to all of our faithful parishioners, members of church organizations, and volunteer workers for their devotion and sincere efforts towards further development and strengthening our church and our community life.

May God always spread the wings of his divine providence over his little and precious flock.

PARISH COUNCIL ANNUAL REPORT: 1972

Members included: Father Arshag; Father Diran; Jack Hacherian; Henry Arslanian; Ralph Chakerian; Mickey Bagdasarian; Florence Karoghlianian; Noubar Abdalian; Kevork Arslanian; Carlos Bozoklian; Nazar Mirakian; Sam Mirakian and Harry Odabashian.

Twenty-one regular meetings were held.

The celebration of St. Vartanantz Day was held on February 20, 1972, at the new cultural hall. Eighty-five guests and members attended the celebration.

On March 13 and 14, Father Arshag attended a clergy retreat. On March 19, Sam Mirakian and Noubar Abdalian attended the Mid-west Diocesan Regional Conference, at St. John's Church, Detroit, Mich.

On April 9, 1972, there was a Dedication Banquet for our new cultural hall. The Guest of honor at the banquet was Primate Archbishop Torkom. The community recognized the Primate's Jubilee Celebration by presenting him with a pen and pencil set. Our new cultural hall was completed in February of 1972. Construction ended in late November and the Sons of Malatia finished interior painting and varnishing in mid-February. In May of 1972, the Parish Council approved an exclusive catering contract with Pasquali Catering. This endeavor has been a financial success and the Council feels it has greatly benefited our community.

On April 23, 1972, the Martyr's Day Commemoration was held. Following dinner a program which included Mayor St. John of Richmond Heights, Judge Nahra and the Director of Utilities for the City of Cleveland. The main speaker was the young and dynamic Richard Nersigian from Detroit. One hundred ten adults and twenty children were in attendance. This included twenty-eight people from Pittsburgh. This was the first Parish Council sponsored event which planned a separate organized program for the children.

On May 5 and 6, 1972, Father Arshag, along with Noubar Abdalian and Ralph Chakerian attended the Diocesan Assembly at St. Peter's Church, Troy, N.Y. (A detailed

report of the assembly, prepared by the delegates, appears elsewhere in this booklet)

Mrs. Anna Karayan was appointed Church School Superintendent for the year of 1972-1973 and Mrs. Florence Geokjian was appointed Director of Religious Study.

The Annual Church Picnic was held on July 2, 1972 on the church grounds. Despite rainy weather 175 people attended. Rain forced the picnic to be moved into the cultural hall, but this did not dampen anyone's spirits.

St. Gregory of Narek once again sponsored a Church Baseball Team. Although they didn't win the championship, they enjoyed their Sunday afternoons. We can be proud of them.

In July, Father Arshag received a letter from the Primate stating that a number of clergymen were to receive new assignments and that he was to be included in this change. Despite letters of appeal from Parish Council and some parishioners, Father Arshag assumed official clergy responsibilities in South Milwaukee on September 10, 1972. On September 10, 1972, a farewell dinner for Father Arshag was held in our cultural hall. The community presented Father Arshag with a camera and many friends and dignitaries gathered to extend their best wishes to Father Arshag.

On October 29, 1972, Father Diran Papazian officially assumed clergy responsibilities at St. Gregory of Narek. Father Diran was welcomed to the community on October 29, 1972 at the Cultural Day Dinner. Following dinner Chairman of Parish Council, Jack Hacherian, introduced Father Diran to the community and a cake in his honor was served. The program for Cultural Day featured main speakers, George Sakian and Father Diran as well as a recitation by the Sunday School. An organized cultural program was planned for the children.

In November the Parish Council decided to charge \$40.00 for the use of the Cultural Hall for a Memorial Dinner of a church member.

The Parish Council again sold Christmas Trees on the church grounds in 1972. The project was a financial success and will be planned again next year.

All financial transactions and other activities initiated by the Parish Council is discussed in the treasurer's report included elsewhere in this booklet.

Projects which the Parish Council has undertaken this year which are not completed include the culvert pipe and cleaning ditch and extended parking lot for our cultural hall. Hopes are that these will be completed in the early part of next year.

The year of 1972 was a very progressive year for our church. Much was accomplished such as the completion of our cultural hall, contract negotiations for catering in the new hall, maintenance arrangements for the hall, and the beginning of the renovation of the Parish House. All this, in addition to a change of parish priests has made 1972 a year we will all remember. Much progress was made to strengthen our community and church for years to come.

DIOCESAN DELEGATES REPORT:

The 70th Annual Assembly of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America was held in St. Peter Armenian Church in Watervliet, Troy, N.Y., on Friday and Saturday May 5-6, 1972.

Some of the major items that were discussed are as follows:

1. Proposal of rotation of clergy was presented to the Diocesan Assembly for consideration. However this proposal was tabled indefinitely because of lack of clergy to properly implement.
2. Amendment to Constitution Article 54 that would add Parish Council Chairman as delegates to the Diocesan Assembly with the same privileges and rights as elected delegates.
3. The Diocesan Assembly moved that the National Council of Churches be asked to express their concern to the Turkish Government over their actions in appropriating Armenian Church property.
4. The Diocesan Assembly decided that more emphasis must be put by the local Parish Priest and Parish Council in assisting the youth to strengthen the ACYOA Chapters or any similar groups that may be formed. In the future each Parish will be responsible for doing what is necessary to strengthen and assist youth in forming meaningful organizations like the ACYOA Jrs. and Seniors.
5. There will be another Emergency Assessment in 1972 to raise enough money to meet the 1972 Diocesan needs. It will be required for another \$55,000 to be raised from the Parishes. Therefore our dues will be increased by approx. another 50%. This means in 1972 we will have to pay to the Diocesan Office \$1,700 instead of \$1,120 as previously assessed.
6. The approved budget for 1972 was \$295,000. Of this amount, \$195,000 must come from the Parishes.
7. The 1973 Diocesan Assembly will be held in Worcester, Mass., in honor of the 75th Anniversary of our Diocese and this was where it all began in Worcester.

EVENTS OF THE YEAR:

During early 1972 construction of the new cultural hall building was completed. The interior tiling and painting was volunteered and accomplished by members of the Sons of Malatia Organization.

Planning was begun for the dedication of the new building scheduled to be held on April 9. The dedication banquet was a great success with 180 persons in attendance. Guests included His Grace Archbishop Torkom Manoogian and Father Nersess Jebejian. Deeran Krikorian, former Building Committee Chairman, served as M.C.

At the dedication banquet pledges were collected for a new three year period beginning in September 1972. A total of \$59,000, including \$10,000 from the AGBU, was pledged by the community.

During the year steps were taken to follow-up on overdue pledge payments. Letters were also sent for new pledges to supplement those received at the dedication banquet.

During the summer months, furniture and equipment for the church school and building were purchased from the Memorial Fund collections.

To improve the sound in the hall, the committee arranged for installation of of accoustical tiling on the ceiling. This work was completed in October.

Future projects include additional parking spaces by covering the gravel adjacent to church driveway, and landscaping around the new building. However, cash is needed in order to make these improvements.
