During the months of June and July, the Women's Guild prepared pastries for our upcoming Annual Picnic. As in past years, the Women's Guild, once again, donated over \$500.00 to defray the costs of all the pastries, which were made by our hard working and talented women. The many cash and pastry donations helped make the Sweet Table profitable. The profits from the Picnic Sweet Table were approximately \$5,100.00.

At the request of the Parish Council, on November 3, 1991, the Women's Guild prepared a wonderful 27th Anniversary Dinner, which was enjoyed by all who attended. The Women's Guild, also at Parish Council's request, prepared a dinner for Vartanantz.

Each year St. Gregory's donates food for Hye Camp. This year the Guild made a batch of choregs. This cost is absorbed by the Parish Council along with donations of cheese and olives and a monetary gift.

There was one condolence visit made to the family of the deceased.

We are few in number, but our women work unselfishly for the betterment of our Church. They volunteer their services whenever called upon to serve in any capacity.

My thanks goes to all of them for their time, talent, generosity and efforts they gave for our Church and for making my position as their Chairwoman an easy one.

As in the past, the Women's Guild is forwarding 60 % of their treasury, \$2,504.00 to the Parish Council at this time.

Last but not least, the Women's Guild wish to thank all of you for supporting our activities throughout the year and pray 1992 will be even greater.
