

Sunday School Annual Report
1985-86 School Year

This report of the St. Gregory Sunday School includes the school year beginning September 15, 1985 through May 11, 1986.

The Sunday School held its Annual Picnic and Registration for the 1985-86 School Year on September 15, 1985. At that time, we had 22 students enrolled. I served as Superintendent, Susu Klugian as Assistant Superintendent, Barbara Baronian as our Assistant and Sandy Bower as Art Coordinator. Our teachers were Alyssa Marcantonio - Pre-School, Janet Frankian - Primary, and Sona Yazijian - Juniors.

With the support of the Ladies Auxillary, Women's Guild and Parish Council we were able to provide the children with interesting texts, make additions to the Sunday School library, and enjoyed Communion Breakfasts on Christmas and Easter.

In November 1985, our Junior Class took the Graduation Exam issued by our Diocese. It was with tremendous pride that we announced our 1st Graduating Class in the history of St. Gregory's Sunday School. Members of the class included Cindy Baronian, Kathy Baronian, Sharon Battle, Ari Caliskan, Arpie Klugian, and Joseph Utas. These young people were presented to our congregation at Closing Ceremonies in May.


