The choir members, as well as the whole Church, were with heavy heart with the loss of our choir directoress, Lillian Mahakian. Thanks to Lillian, we have a choir that is knowledgeable in the songs of the Divine Liturgy (Badarak).

After Lillian's death, from July through October 1972, Deacon Ray Arakelian served as interim choir director.

In October, 1972 with the consent of Deacon Ray and the Parish Council, Mr. Paul Ketchoyian was appointed choir director.

At present the choir consists of approximately 14 members, one organist and a back-up organist. We hope to find another choir director as well as an organist. If there is anyone available, please contact Deacon Ray.

The choir has a forecasted budget of \$317.00 for the fiscal year September, 1972 to September, 1973. At present it has spent \$149.00. (For details see attached budget sheet.)
