During the past year the Parish Council has held monthly meetings with a full agenda and Divine Liturgy has been celebrated monthly by various visiting clergy.

Our Women's Guild has remained active under the leadership of Alice Bogdasarian with a few dedicated workers.

The Council made several attempts to restart the Sunday School and was not able to get anyone who would take the responsibility to teach, even though there is help and materials available from the diocese.

Thanks to Kevork Papazian and the people who help him, we have been able to continue having church dinners.

The steeple and roof of the church building have been in dire need of repairs for a long time and thanks to John Bogdasarian, contracts have been signed for this work to be done. Repairs have been made to the heating plant, the kitchen, and the exterior metal railing and the church building is being cleaned on a regular basis.

I would like to thank Joe Azadian on behalf of the Parish Council for all of his time and hard work with our Baku refugees.

I would also like to thank Pam Russell who has so willingly taken over in my several absences and Hagop Injajikian for all of his time in scheduling our visiting priests.

Finally, I would like to thank each member of the Parish Council for their dedication and hard work during the past year and for the excellent attendance at the Parish Council meetings.

In closing, I would like to say that the fiscal problems as evidenced by a deficit financial sheet will have to be dealt with more aggressively in the coming year.
