This year, 1979, was a very successful one for the choir. The number of faithful participants increased to a sizeable one, most of whom responded weekly to their Sunday obligations. The group has enjoyed each other's company and has developed into a friendly, close-knit unit.

The choir held regular rehearsals during the year under the conscientious and dedicated direction of the choir master, Sub-deacon Alfred Yeznaian.

Der Hayr also participated in these rehearsals and made his presence felt inspirationally and educationally. At the September 18th meeting, new officers were elected: Lucine Adourian, Chairperson; John Wolohojian, Vice-chairman; Lucy Tepikian, Corresponding Secretary; Lucine Wolohojian, Recording Secretary and Sub-deacon John Vakassian, Treasurer. Before September the chairperson was Annette Bashian, the treasurer was Seta Cachoian and Dian Dorian was the secretary.

Our choir participated in the Lenten dinner and program series in March. The Annual Bake Sale held on Sunday, October 21st, under the capable direction of Annette Bashian, was profitable. Other income was derived from plate offerings.

On November 2nd, 3rd, Der Hayr, sub-deacons Alfred Yeznaian and John Vakassian represented our choir as delegates to the Annual Assembly of the Association of the Armenian Church Choirs of America, which functions under the auspices of our Diocese. The Assembly was held in Hartford, Connecticut.
