

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP

MEETING OF THE HOLY CROSS ARMENIAM CHURCH

JANUARY 22, 1967

The Annual Membership Meeting of the Holy Cross Armenian Church was called to order by Mr. Harold Azmelian, Chairman of the Parish Council, at 2:00 PM and was opened with a prayer by the Very Rev. Vatche Hovsepian, Pastor and President. The ladies were thanked, on behalf of the membership, for the luncheon they prepared and served.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS - Mr. Jon Najarian was elected Chairman and Miss Ann Dadaian, Secretary, by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made and seconded that the ballot box officially close at 3:00 PM, but that the Nominating Committee, consisting of Lud Shahbazian, Haig Simsarian and Richard Hachadoorian, be permitted to start counting the ballots at this time. Notion passed.

The 1965 published report booklet was distributed to the attending members.

AGENDA

1. The Minutes of the Annual Membership Meeting of 1965 was read and approved. (Page 5)

REPORTS

A. THE VERY REV. VATCHE HOVSEPIAN, PASTOR, read the Pastor's Annual Report (Pages 10 and 13) to the membership. A motion was made and seconded that Father Vatche's report be accepted with heartfelt thanks and filial love and prayers. Motion passed.

B. THE PARISH COUNCIL REPORT (Pages 16 and 20) was presented by Mr. Armen Kalbian, Secretary.

C. THE MEN'S CLUB REPORT (Page 31) was presented by Mr. Charles Genjian, Corresponding Secretary.

D. THE LADIES AID REPORT (Page 34) was read by Mrs. Zabelle Sahagian, Chairman.

E. THE LADIES EDUCATIONAL REPORT (Page 38) was read by Mrs. Zabelle Sahagian.

Mr. Jon Najarian, Chairman, thanked all the organizations for their excellent reports and commented that these reports truly reflected the spirit and work that the organizations are successfully carrying out.

A motion was made and seconded that the membership accept all the committee reports unanimously. Motion passed.

MR. LUD SHAHBAZIAN, on behalf of the Auditing Committee, 2. which also included Mr. Paul Bogosian and Mr. Jon Najarian, presented his thorough report on the assets of the organizations. Special thanks were expressed to Armen Kalbian whose continued assistance is most appreciated by the Auditing Committee.

Mr. Shahbazian brought to the attention of the membership that on the "Assets of the Holy Cross Armenian Church" (Page 28), the shares of Mass. Investors Trust should be 79 instead of 77.

THE PROPOSED BUDGET for the Year 1967 was presented. A 3. motion was made and seconded that the Proposed Budget be accepted as presented. Motion was passed unanimously.

4. REPAIR OF SKYLIGHT IN CHURCH - Mr. Deran Chopoorian reported that after investigation of the skylight by a roofer, there was no indication of anything loose in connection thereof.

5. RENOVATION OF INTERIOR OF CHURCH CENTER - A motion was made and seconded that this item be tabled and put on the Agenda for the next Annual Membership Meeting.

PANELLING OF THE CHURCH - A motion was made and seconded 6. that this item also be tabled and put on the agenda for the next Annual Membership Meeting.

7. The membership, expressing deep concern over Father Vatche's resignation, requested that an explanation be given as to the reasons for same. Father Vatche stated that the Primate, upon his official visit to our Parish, would properly and formally inform us of the intentions of the Diocese.

A motion was made in the form of a recommendation that the Parish Council look into the advisability of giving a one year's leave of absence to Father Vatche, with compensation. Motion was carried unanimously.

Father Vatche closed the meeting with a prayer and the singing of Hayr Mer.

PASTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT

1967

The year of 1967 has been a period of unprecedented joy for our Community. We celebrated the 60th Anniversary of Parish Life and our growth. The Rt. Rev. Bishop Torkom Manoogian, the Primate of the Diocese, celebrated the Divine Liturgy and presided over the 60th Anniversary Banquet. A Souvenir Booklet was printed for this occasion and hundreds witnessed this epoch-making affair...a day of rededication to serve Him and dwell within His Body, the Nother Church.

For me, this has been a vear of indescribable sadness and avareness of new challenges. I had to leave my parish, not just a community. I had to depart from my home and my children, whose growth, in the wisdom of our Lord, I have observed. I had to leave my very dear people, not just merely an alien group, but I had to leave my own family. While I was alone, but never lonely, wasn't I a part of practically every family of the Holy Cross Armenian Church? I had to leave the rascal-looking angels of the Sunday and Armenian Schools. Next time, probably when I see them, they will be fully matured, some of them already married and caring for their own family as well as the Holy Cross Parish Family. Indeed for me it will be the greatest satisfaction to see my present children in the dynamic leadership of the Holy Cross Armenian Church. That will be our reward.

As in previous years, our total concern was to involve our parishioners effectively in the Holy Mission of the Church.

<u>CHURCH SERVICES</u> - I have always been proud of our Choir. The deacons and the choir members, with their reverend approach and correct manner in the Church, and, of course, exceptionally fine singing, created the much-needed spiritual atmosphere for prayers. The choir members among themselves have truly been friendly. The Deacons, Choirmaster, and the members of the Choir during the past 11 years served the Holy Cross Armenian Church with exemplary dedication. I am confident that they will continue serving and from time to time I shall be invited to conduct services.

During 1967 we had 22 Baptisms, 8 Weddings and 22 Funerals.

LADIES AID - Mrs. Zabelle Sahagian, together with her Executive Committee, gave dynamic leadership to the organization and the Ladies Aid Society. As in previous years, they rendered very valuable service to the Church and Community.

LADIES EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY - Our parish and myself owe a debt of gratitude to this organization. Under rather non-condusive national atmosphere, losing our mother tongue from day to day, they are not sparing money, labor, effort and are utilizing every available means to teach the language of our forefathers. We must make every effort, collectively and individually, to strengthen the Armenian School. Support and care for our children must be our primary objective.

<u>MEN'S CLUB</u> - We cannot say enough about this organization. New young talent is being discovered every day. Their previously sidelined qualities are finding fertile soil in the life of our Community. Theyr many-fold services are greatly appreciated. The positive nature of their planned activities are the expression of their love, concern and dedication. They have set a high standard for themselves, and I hope that they will maintain it honorably.

<u>SUNDAY SCHOOL</u> - We cannot praise our teachers enough. Their dedication, sacrifice and service cannot be compensated with material recognition. Our Sunday School functions quite well, attendance could be improved, but overall the result is satisfactory.

<u>PARISH COUNCIL</u> - It is said "the proof of the pudding is in the eating of it", and how else can I talk about the Parish Council and the Diocesan Delegates. Their young conscientious leadership proved to be more than an asset. I have every reason to believe that they will continue serving in the same exemplary and fruitful manner that they did during the past years. Every member of the inner leadership circle deserve laud and praise. Indeed I express my gratitude for their truly challenging cooperation and at the same time bless them and their families for their selfless dedication. During these trying months our parishioners must cooperate with the Parish Council and its dedicated chairman.

I shall remember the year 1967 with mixed emotions, I was elevated to the rank of Dzayrakouyn Vartabed, a tremendous banquet was given to me organized by the Parish Council, with a generous gift. I went to Geneva, Switzerland, to the World Council of Churches with the Primate as a member of the entourage of our Holy Father, the Catholicos. On October 1, 1967, I was consecrated a Bishop at the Cathedral Church of Holy Etchmiadzin by His Holiness, Vasken I. For the first time in my life, I saw our Motherland, the history of which I have been reading since my childhood. You feel proud seeing the progress of Armenia. Upon my return a banquet was given in my honor by American friends as "The Man of the Year".

Of course, Sunday, December 3, 1967, was the climax of everything. I was breathing heavily and comfortably. After all, our people were not ignorant or blind to appreciate, however small, the services of a Servant of the Lord. I could have burst that day from happiness. That tremendous banquet was a challenge and demand for more service in the vineyard of our Lord. My gratitude, invariably, is expressed to the organizers, particularly Chairman, Philip Arpiarian and his Committee, to all of my parishioners, attending friends and faithfuls. You are all always remembers in my prayers. May the good Lord give you much needed peace of mind, health, spirit of forgiveness and dedication. I have been in Canada now almost three months. The work is tremendously challenging. At the moment, we have almost 10,000 Armenians in Montreal. Over 5000 are in Toronto and in the Ontario Province. I have only two priests - I need urgently, what you need, two priests. Two parishes, St. Catharines and Niagara Falls have been without a priest for many years. Visiting clergy occasionally conduct services. Armenians from the Middle East and Europe have been coming in the hundreds. The Church has to care for them. We are ready to serve...the harvest is plentiful, but laborers are few ...

Please remember me and the Diocese of Canada in your prayers.

May the Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the Love of God and the Communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

During the past year our Parish witnessed several memorable events, with a great deal of tenderness and love toward our former Pastor, the Rt. Rev. Bishop Vatche Hovsepian, and felt justifiably grateful and honored with the events which led to his resignation.

On June 17, 1967, the then Very Rev. Vatche Hovsepian was elevated to the degree of DZAYRAKOUYN VARTABED (Plenary Doctorate) by the Primate. His Grace Bishop Torkom Manoogian, in a very impressive religious ceremony in our Church, assisted by the clergy in the New York-New Jersey area. A banquet followed at the Church Center.

On Sunday, October 1, 1967, the Very Rev. Vatche Dz. Vartabed Hovsepian was ordained Bishop by His Holiness Vasken I, Catholicos of all Armenians in the Cathedral of Holy Etchmiadzin, Armenia. On December 3, 1967, a Testimonial and Farewell Dinner was given in his honor by the Parish Council and Parishioners of the Holy Cross Armenian Church at the Chalet in Rochelle Park, New Jersey, with visiting dignitaries and heads of Church as guests.

Prior to Bishop Vatche's departure for Canada, the M&T Social Club of Union City named him "Citizen of the Year" and honored him with a dinner.

Bishop Vatche left us for the much higher administrative duties and ever-increasing need of the Church as denotes his rank. We wish him good health, God speed, all the good luck in the years ahead, and look forward to his visits to our Parish from time to time.

MR. AND MRS. LUD SHAHBAZIAN

Our Parish was further honored when His Holiness, Vasken I, Catholicos of all Armenians, bestowed upon Mr. Lud Shahbazian the Order of St. Gregory Medal for his past and continued devotion, duty and service to both Church and Community. The St. Gregory Medal is the highest honor that can be given to a layman by the Armenian Church. Bishop Vatche at the December 3 dinner read an Encyclical from His Holiness and presented Mr. Shahbazian with a beautiful cross. A replica of the medal was presented to Mrs. Josephine Shahbazian.

DIOCESAN ASSEMBLY

The Diocesan Assembly was held in Detroit, Michigan on the weekend of May 22, 1967. All the Diocesan Delegates representing our Church were present.

The most significant accomplishments of the Assembly were evidenced by the approval of the following proposals.

- A study of the teaching methods used in the Sunday Schools is being conducted in the Mid-West Parishes. The results of this study should strengthen the teaching in all of our Sunday Schools.
- b. The establishment of a uniform guide for the Stipend a clergyman will receive in the service of a Parish.

The St. John's Church of Detroit is to be complimented for the friendly and efficient manner in which they conducted the Assembly.

PARISH PAPER

The VISION was published faithfully on a monthly basis throughout the year through the untiring efforts of the then Father Vatche Hovsepian and a staff composed of Mrs. Anne Hachadoorian and Miss Ann Dadaian. Special thanks to Mr. John Hovsepian for his preparing the VISION for offsetting.

ENVELOPE SYSTEM

The parishioners' contributions toward the envelope system increased from 149 in 1966 to 165 in 1967. Total collections in 1967 through the envelope system amounted to \$4,400.00.

NEW YEAR'S EVE

The New Year's Eve Celebration was a huge success. Our gratitude is extended to Chairman, Albert Nersesian, and his Committee, consisting of George Holopigian, Carnig Shenloogian and Paul Takakjian, for the splendid job they did. This year's celebration was held jointly with the St. Leon's Armenian Church, Fair Lawn, who was represented by Chairman, Tom Topjian, and his Committee, which included Andy Dabbakian and Zaven Marootian.

60TH ANNIVERSARY DINNER

We were very fortunate to have our Primate, His Grace Bishop Torkom Manoogian officiate at Divine Liturgy and attend our 60th Anniversary Celebration. This was his first official visit to our Parish as Primate.

The great many parishioners of our Community who participated in this dinner, received copies of the beautifully prepared Booklet which chronologically lists our activities and history of Holy Cross since its inception in January, 1907 to the present.

Without any doubt, with the continued assistance of our Church parishioners and the organizational bodies, plus the support given to your Parish Council, Holy Cross Church will continue to function with the aims and endeavors of all in mind to make our Church and Community one of the finest in the Diocese.

ANNUAL PICNIC

The 1967 Picnic was held jointly with the St. Leon's Church of Fair Lawn on their Church grounds. It was a success, both socially and financially.

Paul Takakjian and Carnig Shenloogian, who were Co-Chairmen of the Committee, assisted by the Men's Club, The Ladies Aid and the Parish Council, did an excellent job.

Our heartfelt thanks are extended to the parishioners who supported this function by attending. It is very satisfying and rewarding to know that all our efforts have provided the parishioners with varied and successful activities such as the Picnic.

CUSTODIAN

Upon the resignation of Mr. Michael DeVito, the Parish Council hired the services of Mr. Paul Borngesser as Custodian of the Church.

RENOVATING REAR OF CHURCH CENTER

The following work was done enlarging the Church Center to its present modern condition.

- 1. All existing partitions were removed and taken away from the premises.
- 2. Necessary support beams and lolly columns needed to support the balcony were installed.
- 3. Built wall and closet across Bergenline Avenue side of building the width of the existing stairway to the second floor.
- 4. Continued plywood in the new area duplicating plywood now installed in center.
- 5. All necessary plastering on the ceiling and walls was done.
- 6. The existing floor was prepared for application of kentile, or ozite carpet.
- 7. Ceiling was lowered in new area.
- 8. Opening at top of Center steps to next building was finished.

When all this work was completed, the floors of the Church Center was subsequently refinished and polished to its present state.
