MEMORIAL COMMITTEE REPORT - 1968

The past year has seen the installation of our stained glass windows. We are happy to report that 8 of the windows have been sold to date. The two remaining windows cost \$7,000 each. Two or more families will be able to share the expense of a window if they wish. Anyone interested should contact the committee.

We have also purchased two votive candle stands. These stands were designed and constructed by famed sculptor Bogdan Grom.

Three eternal lamps have been made and are being installed. These lamps depict the inverted dome of our church and will hang over each of the altars.

By this time the baptismal font and baptismal screen have also been installed. The font is a bronze, free form sculptor depicting water. The screen behind this font depicts the vision of St. Gregory the Illuminator.

There are still a few pews and pew seats available. The pews cost \$500 each and the pew seats are \$100 each.
