BRIEF ACCOUNTS OF SOME PASTORAL ACTIVITIES DURING 1975

Dear Parishioners:

At this Annual Parish Assembly, we have come together to assess our accomplishments of the past year and to plan for the future. We have cause for gratification for a deed well done in the name of our beloved Church. As for our future, we shall achieve even greater accomplishments with the help of God as He guides us to the fulfillment of our goals. It is my hope and prayer that we shall accept all challenges in our zeal to work for the constant growth and enrichment of our Church.

The Holy Trinity Armenian Church is dedicated to the fulfillment of every spiritual need of its congregation in all respects. The Church has something to offer all of us, every requirement large or small can be achieved through the medium of our Church.

During my tenure in this outstanding community, I have been most fortunate in receiving the support and encouragement of Rev. Fr. Papken Maksoudian who has devotedly served Holy Trinity Church for the last 23 years. His services have been invaluable to me because of his efficiency, experience and his willingness to assist me in Pastoral activities.

My report encompasses the following areas:

CHURCH SERVICES

Each Sunday of the year, Divine Liturgy was held and appropriate sermons were delivered. All Church services were conducted with solemnity and in a dignified manner. It is significant to mention the loyal and dedicated services, particularly those of our Choir Director Very Rev. Oshagan Minassian, Organist, and all of the Deacons, Acolytes and Choir Members whose involvement has beautified and enriched our services.

SACRAMENTS

The following services have been duly recorded in our parish registers for 1975:

Baptism and Confirmations	18
Weddings	13
Funerals	35

VISITATIONS

This aspect of our work is of prime importance. Visitations to hospitals, and nursing homes for the sick and elderly, home visitations for shut-ins, counseling, condolence calls and fellowship visits have been given high priorities at all times. We have also initiated visits to newly wedded couples.

It is important that our people know that the Church is very much concerned with their welfare. In consideration of the vast area

covered by our membership, it is essential to extend our visitation program. The only feasible way of doing this will be to involve the entire community in the program. Perhaps parishioners could be designated to small groups to make calls on families in order to bring them into closer contact with their fellow members. We must realize that our Christian duty requires us to extend ourselves to our friends in this way. Only then can our community be strong, unified and healthy.

ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES

The administrative duties of the Pastor includes office work and management, attendance at meetings of the Parish Council, general body and executive committees of our Church organizations, standing committee meetings, and attendance of organizational functions and the formation and execution of cultural and educational programs.

Special thanks are due to our Church Secretary, Mrs. Rose Mamishian for her concern and dedication.

PARISH SCHOOLS

Both Armenian and Sunday School began their 1975 - 1976 academic year with a full program and new zeal. We are gratified that both schools are functioning successfully. We are extremely impressed with the dedication of the Superintendents and Teachers and the quality of their work with our children. There is no doubt that our parishioners will continue to extend every effort toward the success of these vital activities.

CHURCH PUBLICATIONS

The "Dajar", official paper of our Parish, was published monthly during 1975 and was sent to approximately 1300 parishioners and friends including the Churches of our Diocese and the Diocese of California.

Sunday Bulletins were prepared and distributed to the congregation. Special brochures and announcements of various occasions have been mailed to our membership.
