

ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY  
HOLY TRINITY ARMENIAN APOSTOLIC CHURCH

Cambridge, Massachusetts  
Sunday, February 1, 1981

The Annual Parish Assembly of the Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church in Cambridge, Massachusetts was held on Sunday, February 1, 1981 in the Cultural Hall with Pastor Mampre Kouzouian presiding.

The meeting was called to order by the Parish Council Chairperson, Mrs. Helene Dorian at 1:00 p.m.

Mr. Diran Zahigian, Chairman of the Nominating Committee conducted the election of the day's Tivan.

The minutes of the 1980 Parish Assembly was read by Mrs. June Carlon and accepted as read.

Mr. Diran Zahigian introduced the nominees for election at the Annual Parish Assembly.

At this time, question was raised and discussion followed regarding a time limit on keeping the Ballot Box open at the Annual Assembly. Upon motion duly made and seconded, it was then

VOTED: To have the Ballot Box remain open until 3:00 p.m.

Mrs. Helene Dorian explained the new ballot and system of voting.

At this time, a thirty minute recess was called for the purpose of the Annual voting. The meeting was reconvened at 2:00 p.m.

Pastor's Report:

Father Mampre explained and expressed the need of a Youth Director for the A.C.Y.O. Jrs. and assured the parents that they are searching for one. If there is anyone they know of, please let him know.

Mr. Sarkis Boghosian asked for an explanation for paragraph 7, page 2D. Father Mampre explained a committee consisting of Archie Kolligian, John Soursourian, Aetna Tashjian and the Parish Council, with the help of our parishioners, to erect a Martyrs Memorial Monument on the church grounds.

Parish Council's Activities and Financial Report:

Helene Dorian explained the change of date of our Annual Church Picnic from the second Sunday of September to June 7, 1981.

Mrs. Borzakian congratulated the Parish Council on the redecorating of the ladies room.

Mr. John Soursourian questioned the amount of \$3,926.95 in 1980 compared to \$789.71 in 1979 for the Cultural program. Mr. Donald Tellalian stated the Berberian concert brought the cost up.

Budget:

Miss Roxie Hedison question the budget of \$3,500.00 for the Cultural program. After much discussion a motion duly made and seconded, it was VOTED: To keep within the budget of \$3,500.00

The proposed budget for 1981 of \$236,000.00 was accepted as presented.




A total of 122 ballots were cast. Father Mampre congratulated the newly elected officers.
