

ST. JAMES ARMENIAN CHURCH CHOIR REPORT

During 1982, the choir felt the need for new robes. We asked the parish members for donations. We received 23 donations of \$35.00 each, plus one \$10.00 donation. Making a total of \$815.00. The choir had \$180.00 in the bank, which was added to the \$815.00. Making a grand total of \$995.00. All monies have been turned over to the Parish Council.

So far we have paid \$647.50. Which leaves \$347.50. However, there was a mistake on two of the robes. One of the medium size robe had a small label marking and one of the medium size alter sever robe had a laege size label marking.

We received 17 robes. We had ordered 20. Three were back ordered. Two Medium choir robes and one alter server robe. We had to add one large alter server robe to the order to make up for the mistake. Therefore we will receive four more robes when they are ready and will have to pay \$140.00 more. We will have 21 robes all to-gether.
