## General Assembly Meeting

The general membership meeting was called to order by temporary chairman Armand Bendian on February 9, 1963.

Reverend Kalfayan gave a prayer.

Harry Habedian read the minutes of the previous meeting. Nerses Karamanian then read the minutes in Armenian. Both minutes were approved as read.

Mike Hayalian stated that the cemetery report would be given after the auditing committee audits the books.

Charley Kademian reported that \$12,403.71 remains to be paid on the building. To date, \$234.66 interest has been paid. Margaret Kademian presented a check in the amount of \$480.00 from the Young Women's Guild.

The budget and pledge system were presented by Harry Nabedian. After a thorough discussion, Grace Hadjinian made a motion that in order for a member to be in good standing, they would have to pay a \$1.00 minimum pledge per week plus their dues. Dues would be reaised to \$30.00 for all married couples, \$20.00 for single persons and \$10.00 for widows.

Nerses Karamanian questioned the Parish Council and Building Committee about the nameplates for the memorials, liens on the building, if any, and names of those who have not paid their pledge. He was answered: Name plates would be made up in the very near future; no liens on the Church building; and there will be no announcements about members who have or have not paid their pledge until December of 1963 when the three-year period will be over.
