We are in receipt of your letter wherein you request complete information concerning the schedule of the 62nd Diocesan Assembly which will be held at Holy Resurrection Armenian Apostolic Church in South Milwaukee.

The Assembly meetings will be held in the nave of the Church. The dinners will be served in the Hall of the Church. The delegates will be housed at the Coach House Motor Inn, 1926 W. Wisconsin Ave., Milwaukee, Wis., and they will commute by charter bus which will be made available to us by the management of the Hotel. The cost of this transportation is included in the room charge.

The main banquet will be held on Saturday, May 2, 1964 at 8:00 P.M. sharp. In my previous letter to you, I informed you that this was discussed by His Grace and me, and we arrived at this conclusion. His Grace will discuss the matter with the Central Council and instead of having four sessions, they will finish in three sessions. If this is impossible, with the permission of His Grace, a fourth session will be held on Sunday afternoon. We did try to hold the banquet on Sunday evening, but there was no suitable plade available to us. We hope the Central Council will permit us to hold the banquet on Saturday night.

The Committee Members and Parish Council of Holy Resurrection Armenian Church believe that a social gathering or hospitality night is appropriate, and we have set this for Friday night at the Coach House Motor Inn at 10:30 P.M. We believe this will be an opportune time for the delegates, Parish Council, and committee members to acquaint themselves, and promote fellowship and Christian love amongst us.
