Excerpts from Parish Council Report

- 1. During 1964, 2 Parish Assemblies were held.
- 2. Formed a Planning Committee to report on the feasability of a Building Program.
- 3. Adopted a weekly pledge envelope system, which has proved most succesful.

Excerpts from Pastor's Report

- 1. In addition to sacraments reported in Annual Report, Parish Priest performed 8 baptisms, 1 wedding and 8 1 funeral elsewhere.
- 2. 55 Holy Badaraks were celebrated in 1964, as well as 20 other separate liturgical services. 70 sermons were preached.
- 3. One person, already baptised and confirmed in the Roman Catholic Church, was received into the Armenian Church.
- 4. The Parish Priest made 343 pastoral visits, 108 sick calls, had 34 counselling sessions, attended 182 organizational

meetings and gatherings, attended 12 inter-parish meetings and 2 community meetings, and gave 35talks in the parish. 5. An Adult study group met 19 times and a Spiritual Life Conference met 4 times under the leadership of the Pastor, who also taught Acolytes, an Armenian School and Christian Doctrine classes. 6. The Pastor also participated in 16 other functions outside of the Parish, such as spoke at ACYOA Day celebrations in Chicago, Detroit, and New York, directed an AGYOA Jrs. retreat in Detroit, directed a Mid-Western Summer Camp for Armenian Church children for one week, etc. . 7. In addition to his pastoral work, the Pastor is a part of the staff at the St. Nersess Armenian Theological School in Evanston and is there $2\frac{1}{2}$ days per week.
