PARISH COUNCIL. Effective with the Parish Assembly of February 13, 1966, the Parish Council of St. Mary's Armenian Apostolic Church of Washinton D. C. shall consist of seven members. Accordingly, three members will be elected at the Parish Assembly on February 13, 1966 and four members the following year, each group to serve for terms of two years.

MEMBERSHIP. Membership in St. Mary's Armenian Apostolic Church of Washington D. C. shall be granted upon application to all persons who have been baptized and confirmed in the Armenian Chruch, who accept its doctrines, canons and rites, and who fulfill their obligations to the church and community. As part of his obligation, each member shall pledge and pay annual dues of not less than \$50.00 starting with the calendar year 1966. Reductions in this annual dues minimum may be granted, on an individual basis, by the Parish Council, upon request of parishioners whose circumstances warrant such exception.
