I will briefly describe some of the activities of the A.C.Y.O.A. during this past year. Before this, I would like to mention that this year our advisor is Dr. Baker and that the other officers are Edward Bedurian, vice chairman, David Terzian, secretary; and Patricia Krikerian, treasurer. We have fourteen members.

The A.C.Y.O.A. has recently engaged in four fund-raising activities. We held a candy sale from which we made \$85. \$65. of this was turned over to the Parish Council for church beautification. The remainder will be given charity. For Halloween we held a pumpkin sale and for Thanksgiving we held a turkey raffle. At the Church Bazaar we had a booth that made over \$150., which was given to the Church. We now have \$65. romaining in our treasury.
