Modification and enlargement of existing facilities.

Under each consideration we provide preliminary design program, as follows:

1. Revised planning
2. Application of same materials, brick and stone masonry (where applicable)
3. Continuation of same architectural motif, openings, windows, etc.
4. Repetition of same pitched roof.

Existing conditions

1. Lot : 115'-0" x 125'-0"
2. Zoning ordinances Zone : R-2
Setback : 15'-0" from both streets
20'-0" backyard (from alley)
8'-0" sideyard (from neighbor)
Height : 40'-0" (existing apex of roof)
3. Estimated Cost : from 150,000 to 200,000 dollars

To implement this plan, especially under existing difficult economic conditions (which would be advantageous for us) we would require:

1. Approval and collaboration of our members.
2. Organization and assistance to substantiate budget.

Under these circumstances we desperately urge our members to react favorably for the sake of our ever growing youth. This will create a healthier environment and in the long run be beneficial to all. We trust that our new generation will, in the future, contribute to the effort and money required to bring to fruition the ideal of a more complete environment.
