## Mime Games Are Fun for Children

"Chip Off the Old Munk," a production of the new Turtle Bay Company is a mime entertainment for children—a same of show but-no-tell. And so it she antithesis of the sensory bombardment that the television generation is accustomed to.

But the children appear to welcome the change, adjust to it quickly, and remain on the edge of their seats quietly engrossed. From initial queries ("Can they talk?"), they move to complete understanding ("Look, they're sharing").

The show stars impish Rasa Allen and agile David McGee, and their careful evocation of mood and character demonstrates that action can indeed speak louder than words. The production is believable, polished, and clever.

A clown holds up placards with the title of each vignette (there are eight) and pantomimes it so that even children too young to read can understand. "Pirates in a Dark Cave," "A Fishy Story," "Midnight in the Museum," "A Winter Fantasy" and "Circus" (the audience may join in this one) are some of the themes. 
