RESOLUTIONS ON THE ARMENIAN GENOCIDE BEFORE THE U.S. CONGRESS There are presently two resolutions: the first designates April 24 as a National Day of Remembrance, and the second affirms U.S. recognition of the historic facts of the Armenian Genocide.

Board member Gregory Devejian's letters to Senators Domenici and Bingaman on behalf of this Association resulted in satisfactory responses. Telegrams were sent to Representatives Lujan, Richardson and Skeen, in addition to the earlier letters. Their replies are expected.

April 1 through 27

At Cleveland Middle School 90 children divided into several classes are learning to look at history, behavior and themselves as they study the Holocaust and the Armenian Genocide. Their teacher for each of these daily 40-minute classes is Annette Chakerian. You are invited to observe a class. (Annette C. at #883-1897.) She was one of four teachers who prepared at the Brookline, Mass. Workshop last summer. Contributions are sought in Albuquerque for two additional teachers for the Summer 1984 Workshop. The cost is primarily the air-fare--about \$500 for each. Another set of classroom books is needed as this budget item for APS was not funded. \$10 each or \$7/100.

April 13 to 16 in Paris, France

The Permanent Tribunal of the People, "an independent, non-governmental international court of justice"met this past weekend to consider the case of the Armenian Genocide. The extensive agenda included two witnesses on videocassette, one of which was a 15-minute segment of Mariam Hapetian Davis's description of her childhood experience. From Terjan, Garin (Erzeroum), Mrs. Davis and her family first came to live in New Mexico in 1936. The published proceedings will be distributed by the Zoryan Institute. (Information: #256-9266)
