Sunday, August 14th, two vans of members attended the Ascension Day Services at St. Gredory the Illuminator Armenian Apostolic Church in Granite City, Illinois. Ara took his wife, Paddy, and Zaven, Zartar, Esther, Mary and Emily Hatutian. With them also was Rosy Onbachian. The Baptists met us there in Granite City. The Badarak was meaningful and the grapes were blessed and given to us all at the picnic following the service. We were entertained at their center and in the home of the Priest. The group left before dawn and arrived home after dark, but it was a memorable occasion and the second year that we attended.

Dr. Terian's Lecture series on the Heritage of the Armenian People began on Thursday evening August 18th and has continued every Thursday evening until now. We have traced the history of the Armenian nation from its origin to the present. When Dr. Terian has been called out of town we have had lectures by Dr. Jeremy Baptist, Tom Hayrabedian, Armen Youssefi, Zaven W and Ara Zakaryan.
