As a result of the Diocesan Council meeting held on Friday, May 29, 1981 it has been agreed that no further action be taken regarding plans for the Holy Trinity Church in Toronto in conjunction with the A.G.B.U.

The reason for the above is based on the decision that there has been no legal documentation presented for this project to the Diocesan Council.

To date, we have received letters of intent only which are insufficient for the transfer of any further funds to the A.G.B.U.

The Diocesan Council deems it necessary that legal instruments be drawn immediately between the involved parties so as to explain the position of all pertinent matters including the number of parking spaces, easements, etc.
