I am in receipt of your letter of the 13th and am sorry to note that it has been impossible for you to get an evaluation on the Russian (500 rouble) Nationalized Bonds that I donated to the Church together with several other books.

I know there is no monetary value to these bonds inasmuch as they have been nationalized and are not redeemable. However, their value lies in the fact that they are comparatively old and I doubt there are many to be found. This would tend to make them valuable and I am sure interesting to the people of Soviet Armenia.

I feel that the books donated should be equally desirable for either the library or the Armenian Museum.

I wish I could help you with an evaluation but I regret that I cannot. Since I do not want you to go to any further trouble, I will accept any fair evaluation you put on my donation.

I trust this will help you to resolve this matter without any further work.
