All donations received by the Diocese or the Cathedral are acknowledged as a matter of course by receipts. There may be some confusion in the matter of in lieu of flowers donations because such donations are usually assigned to two or more institutions. We can only acknowledge the part of the donation that is actually received by us. Of course, there is always the possibility of error in occasional instances, but this is our practice.

All in lieu of flowers donations received by the Diocese are credited according to the indications made by the donor, whether it be the Cathedral, the Diocese, the Building Fund, Memorials, etc. In the latter cases the monies are forwarded to you for appropriate disposition. An example is the \$500 donation made recently by Mrs. Rose McCool in memory of Freda and Boghos Boyajian for an ornamental Gospels book.
