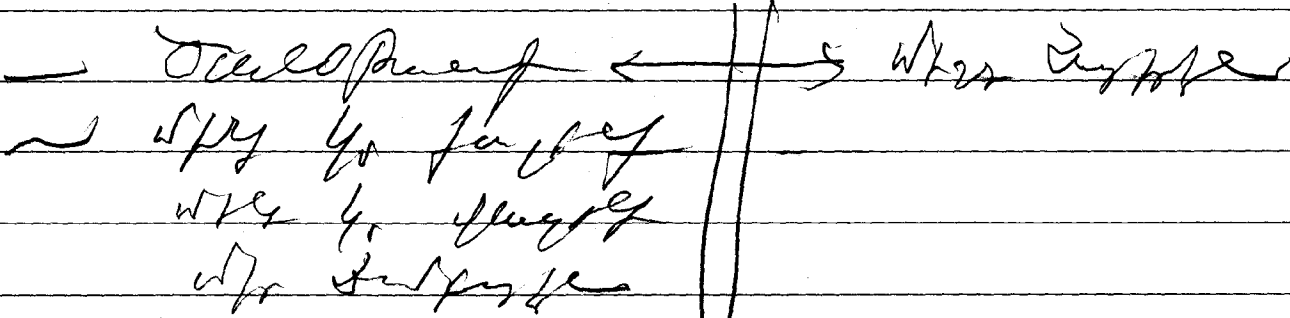

We are very grateful to you for your recent correspondence and for the video of our visit to Niagara Falls and Buffalo. How kind of you to forward it to us along with the four TV cups.

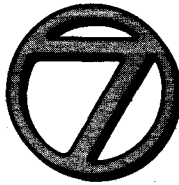
That visit was indeed a very special one. We were very touched by the children, by the warmth of everyone we met and by the goodness and decency of the people of this part of the country.

We very much enjoyed having you with us. You did an excellent job in thanking the people of Western New York for their help. Very best wishes and warm regards.

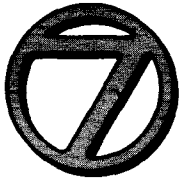


Dear Archbishop Manoogian:

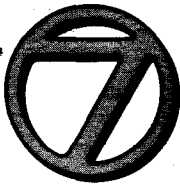

Dear Archbishop Torkom:

In addition to the previous monies forwarded from the Western New York community, we also have some additional contributions to the Armenian Diocese Earthquake that we received after our check presentation.

As you can see, there is a great well of generosity among Western New Yorkers to help others less fortunate. This brings our total contributions through WKBW-TV to \$7888.87.

You may also be aware that of the 37 children from Soviet Armenia who came to the United States for medical treatment, 10 of these children came to the City of Buffalo. We are caring for a greater number of children than any other city in the United States, and we are very glad to provide this help. Eight out of the ten children are at our local Children's Hospital in Buffalo for which this station conducts a telethon and raises over one million dollars every year to go toward hospital equipment and operations.


In view of this very close nexus to the Armenian community by Western New Yorkers, I would very much like you to consider a visit to our city for the purpose of going to the hospital and visiting with the children. Representatives of the Niagara Falls church community have been very supportive and helpful in this cause. I would also like you to appear on our local morning show that is broadcast from 10am to 11am and speak to the many Western New Yorkers who have shown such great concern for the Armenian children.

Also, as the leading representative of the Armenian church community, you would be able to bring a responsiveness and interaction with the larger community. This would generate much goodwill and could only be a positive step in the overall

Dear Archbishop Manoogian:

We are all very pleased and enthused that you will be coming to visit us in Buffalo next week. On Monday afternoon, we plan to have our television cameras present for your arrival at the airport. I understand that your office will make arrangements for representatives from the Niagara/Buffalo communities to meet you at the airport. Depending upon the availabilities, we also would like to cover the 7:30pm meeting in Niagara Falls at the Saint Sarkis Church.

On Tuesday morning at 9:30am, I will meet you at the Hyatt to bring you to our television station for appearance on AM Buffalo. The program is a live studio presentation that is broadcast from 10-11am. Although I do not know the exact time that your segment will be scheduled, I can discuss that with you at 9:30am. During the program, it would be appropriate to discuss the impact of the earthquake disaster and the help given from the many communities, particularly those in Buffalo who contributed to the Earthquake Relief Fund. If you do have photographs of conditions in Armenia, that would be an opportunity to give a visual portrayal.

After the television show appearance, we will go to Children's Hospital of Buffalo where most of the Armenian children who came to Western New York were treated, and then to the Ronald McDonald House where they stayed. We will make arrangements for lunch.

Your suggestion to bring an offering of thanks, such as a Cross, would be very nice. Certainly, there are individuals at the hospital for whom this would be a welcomed gift, as well as those who work at the Ronald McDonald House. In all, I believe that approximately 24 would be enough.


