Plaza and stalls must be made attractive.

Program

Stalls set up according to Press, author (Saroyan, Arlen, e.g.), subject matter (religion, fiction, etc.). A special stall a must for Saroyan.

Stalls for records, with music playing in that area, or over the PA system.

Refreshments: simple, coffee, beverages, lahmajune, etc.

Features: authors speaking for a minute or so on the PA system, autographing, etc.; Musicians performing and autographing; cooking demonstrations at cookbook counter; art stalls with artists present; Armenian language books and author.

Receptions for participants.

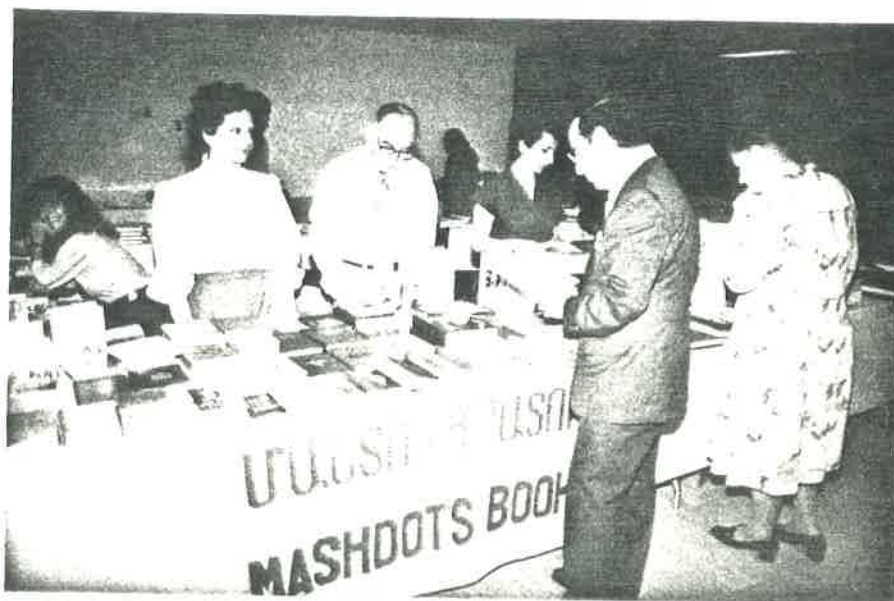
