### 2. Meetings:

Twelve regular monthly meetings were held to handle on-going church business.

One special meeting was held on August 1, 1982 with the Parish Council Sub-Committee to review plans for the kitchen renovations.

### 3. Church Enterprises:

The following church enterprises were conducted in cooperation with our various church organizations and individual volunteers:

#### a) Diocesan Assembly

During the week of May 3, 1982 we hosted the Eightieth Annual Diocesan Assembly. Under the very capable leadership and management of Charles Avedisian and his committees, the dedicated efforts of all our parish members and with the friendly cooperation of St. Francis of Assisi Church this ADA was one of the most successful ever held. Our own Fr. Vartan Der Assadourian was honored as one of the Twelve Servants of God. A net income of \$11,471. was realized.

### b) ACYOA Sports Week

During the week of September 1, 1982, we assisted the ACYOA Srs. who hosted the 13th Annual Sports Weekend and General Assembly under the guidance and enthusiastic leadership of Gary Hovhanesian and Sharon Vartanian and their capable assistants. This sports weekend was a tremendous athletic, social and financial success. A financial report will be given by the ACYOA.

### c) Church Picnic

A picnic was held on the church premises on August 21, 1982 under the chairmanship of Richard Kallajian and assisted by the Women's Guild and individual volunteers. A net profit of \$418. was realized.

### d) Second Anniversary Banquet

The 2nd Anniversary Banquet was held in the Abrahamian Auditorium on September 26, 1982 with Frank Avakian Stoneson as our Guest of Honor. Under the guidance of Rose Badrigian, Chairwoman and Edward Simonian, Master of Ceremonies and assisted by the Women's Guild this was a very successful affair realizing a net income of \$23.00 and Church donations of \$7,225.

### e) New Year's Eve Social

On December 31, 1982 the Parish Council hosted a New Year's Eve Social in the Abrahamian Auditorium. Intended to be an evening of social fellowship and cheer it was a successful affair although attendance was light. Chaired by Sarkis Yirigian and assisted by the Women's Guild this anticipated nonprofit social yielded a slight net income of \$102.

# 4. Church Operations

# a) Building Committee

Last year's report listed five (5) open items to be completed. Status of these items is as follows:

- 1. Architect's fee the unpaid balance of \$7,500 has now been paid.
- 2. Church sign a price quote, based upon the architect's plans, of approximately \$2,000. has been obtained. In view of the cost, other alternatives are being considered but in any event this project will be completed in 1983.
- 3. Altar painting this painting was completed by Haig Toumayan, consecrated by Archbishop Torkom Manoogian during the Annual Diocesan Assembly and was put in place. Mr. Toumayan has also consented to donate two (2) side altar paintings expected to be completed by late spring 1983.
- 4. Kitchen renovations new cabinets and sinks were installed.
- 5. Memorial Plaque this item remains open but is expected to be completed in 1983.

### b). Other items of note

- 1. Inscription over the Altar was completed.
- 2. Baptismal font repairs were completed.
- 3. Through the generosity of Edward & Alice Simonian we now have a portable refrigerator in our kitchen.
- 4. Building maintenance continues under the direction of John Maljanian and Peter Bagdigian.
- 5. Costs of all landscaping and grounds maintenance were donated by Peter and Margaret Bagdigan.
- 6. Cost of snow removal from driveway and parking lot was donated by Donald Azarigian.
