Choir Director & Asst Director were awarded ^{M.E. Haggopian} Scholarships by the AACCA for vocal training. Our church was represented at the annual choir assembly in Worcester, MA by two delegates, the Parish Priest and three other choir members joined the delegates to participate in the Saturday workshop. Choir rehearsals were held throughout the year. Several Sunday School students have been coming to choir to sing instead of going into church with their S.S. class.
