Please note that we have been approached by the Egyptian Coptic Community in Houston, through their Father Yohanna Tadros Guirguis, in relation with our Church facilities. They are interested in using our Chapel for their religious services once a week, either Saturday or preferably Sunday, and also, one evening for Bible study.

They say that they are in the process of getting organized, they have bought a plot already, but they will not be able to stand on their own only after a year or two. They number approximately 70 people.

Father Guirguis, recently ordained in Egypt, used to be an accountant in Houston with a localMortgage Company(Loomas & Nettleton). He is expressing his devouted belief to the Christian Dogmas of the Armenian Church, so says he, which is closer in ties with the Coptic Church, considering other Orthodox churches. For this reason, according to him, they do not want to continue the monthly use of the Greek Orthodox Church of Houston. He will accept any monthly contribution toward defraying our expenses and other.

Enclosed is a copy of a letter of credentials in the form of a certificate issed to Father Guirguis by the Coptic Orthodox Patriarcate of Egypt. When asked about referrals in the United States about his authority and his congregation, he could only refer to their See in Egypt.

I will appreciate if you could give us your opinion on this subject the soonest possible.
