PROPOSAL TO THE 1988 ACYOA GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO AMEND THE ACYOA CONSTITUTION

AMENDMENT:

Article 13, Section 1 shall read:

The fiscal year shall be from January first to December thirty-first.

Passed
PRESENTLY:

Article 13, Section 1 reads:

The fiscal year shall be from July first to June thirtieth.

ADDITIONAL:

This amendment shall be effective on January 1, 1987.

RATIONALE:

The present fiscal year is often confusing, particularly in terms of dues collection and eligibility to participate in the National Sports Weekend.

Rejected

Ratioale: We propose that this suggestion be rejected as submitted, and feel that a re-submission should be more thought out, in as that, the entire issue of re-structuring of the fiscal year was not taken into account.

- 1) Addressing the problem of terms of the officers of the governing bodies of the ACYOA.
- 2) Timing of the submission of the annual dues.
- 3) Timing of the general assembly.

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT:
AMENDMENT TO BE NAMED: ARTICLE 12, SECTION 5**

* A detailed report , including financial records shall be kept by the Host Chapter. The reports and event proceeds shall be sent to the Central Council within ninety days of the event.

If written request is received by the Central Council before the deadline, the Central Council may extend the deadline by no more than an additional ninety days at their discretion.

The Sports Weekend Host Chapter shall offer an "Eligibility Package Plan" consisting of a minimum of Saturday evening dance and Sunday Awards Banquet and dance, and the cost of this "Eligibility Package Plan shall not exceed one-half of the cost of a Sports Weekend Package Plan, which includes all events offered by the host chapter.

PRESENTLY:

Article 5, Section 2 reads:

Passed

Annual dues for ACYOA members shall be designated by the General Assembly. One-half of the amount shall be sent to the ACYOA Central Council Treasurer. The minimum annual dues shall be ten dollars (\$10.00). Dues become delinquent with the start of the third quarter of the fiscal year (January 1st).

RATIONALE:

This amendment will make dues collection and payment easier, as the chapters and Central Council will be working with calendar year dates.

To be considered a member of the national ACYOA, it is still in the best interests of individuals and chapters to pay dues early in the calendar year.

Rejected as submitted

We feel that this Amendment goes hand in hand with the previous one, and a rejection of the former should also mean a rejection of this amendment.

ADD THE FOLLOWING:

ARTICLE 10, SECTION 14

* THE ACYOA EXECUTIVE SECRETARY SHALL HAVE A NON-TRANSFERABLE
RIGHT OF VOICE AT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
