Dear ACYOA Central Council Members,

As we decided at the last ACYOA Central Council meeting, the Executive Update will be distributed to our entire National Armenian Youth Mailing Listing via each Regional Representative. This means you must be prepared to duplicate the copy you will receive, preparing it for a "bulk rate" postal stamp, and address them according to the mailing-sticker-list you will receive. If you are organized, this will not be a tedious process.

However, keep in mind that the Update should be sent out soon after you receive it. Some of the information contained in the Update is timely, and therefore should not sit around in your home too long! As usual, a copy will be sent to all Chapter Chairmen and the Pastor/Parish, first class from our office. At the same time, you will receive your copy for duplicating purposes.

BE PREPARED. The next Update is scheduled for the first week in December.

We hope that this process works out. It is very important for our members and prospective members to receive our materials, information and announcements. If you have an "regional news" or specific information needed for publication, please forward and it will probably be placed in the next issue upon receipt.

In addition, we must solicit the names and addresses of the thousands of Armenian young people we do not have. The procedure for the General Armenian Youth Listing remains, but the Chapters must be reminded and instructed. Also, if we could use "address cards" at major dances and events, having the attendees fill them out as they enter, we can boost our numbers. (Of course this means someone must go to the dance or event to execute this.)

We look forward to receiving your copies of correspondence and Parish Visitation Reports.....
