At this occasion we also wish to repeat our profound gratefulness for:

1. The Books You donated us, which made the foundation of our Library, as well as those you donated recently, a list of which will appear in our News.
2. The Four times You sent a Badarakich with absolutely NO CHARGE on us.
3. The encouragement You gave to our Deacon, Dr. Sevhonkian, both Moral and Financial.

In our First meeting of this year, September 1963, Dr. Sevhonkian told us that You answered his letter personally over the phone just before he left for Pittsburgh, expressed Your appreciation for his plan and that You were willing to pay the expenses for his trips just as you pay for the Priests. He told us that he answered he was also willing to share and also that he was going to suggest that our Community brings his share, by \$5 per visit.

During our meeting he did suggest that our share be \$5 per visit. We objected to this and wanted to pay all. He said if \$5 is too little we could pay \$10 for each visit, and if the Arachnortaran pays \$10, only \$10 will be left for him, as each visit costs him over \$30. In our next meeting at his absence we decided to make our Church Services once every three months instead of once a month, and pay ALL. Next time he came in October we informed him of our decision, to which he absolutely disagreed, saying that he was coming by Your Authorization, and unless You order him to stop, nobody else could, as long as the keys of the Church are given to him. We had no choice but to agree.

Now, with our Services of yesterday we terminated our year 1963-1964. July and August we will have no Church Services due to the extremely hot and humid climate here. So, we thought that together with the termination of the year

year it will be very nice to pay him also our share of his expenses, even though he never asked for it.

September to June are Ten months. We missed January due to his absence, so for the nine months our share would be \$90.00, Ninety Dollars, which we mailed to him by a check just today.

May we humbly suggest that the Arachnortaran does the same, paying him His share of \$90.00 (9x10), and automatically the remaining \$90.00 will be his own share, which he has accepted so gladly, his accomplishment being his reward, as he puts it.

Settling our accounts with him at this time will encourage us to ask him to make new plans for the year 1964-1965.

Repeating our profound gratefulness for Your help to our small Community, we are.

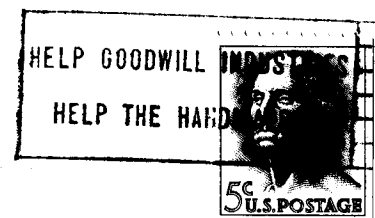
