George Stevoff is president and director of Laub Group Inc., a position he has held since July 1984. Prior to that he served as executive vice president since March 1975. In his capacity he is chief operating officer of the firm which he joined in 1969. Prior to his present position he was affiliated with another prominent Wisconsin agency for 15 years.

He is past president of both the Independent Insurance Agents of Milwaukee and the Independent Insurance Agents of Wisconsin. He has served as State Chairman of the Hartford Insurance Group Agents Council, Home Insurance Co. Regional Council, a member of the Atlantic Mutual's National Agents Council and Crum & Foster National Agents Council. He confronted the congressman in Washington D.C. and expressed the displeasure of the Armenian Community of Wisconsin citing the mistruths and inaccuracies of his position and claims; whereby reminding Mr. Moody of the truth of the Armenian Genocide and how his overt insensitivity to the Armenian people was an injustice to his own political career as a Congressman. **300 pts.**
