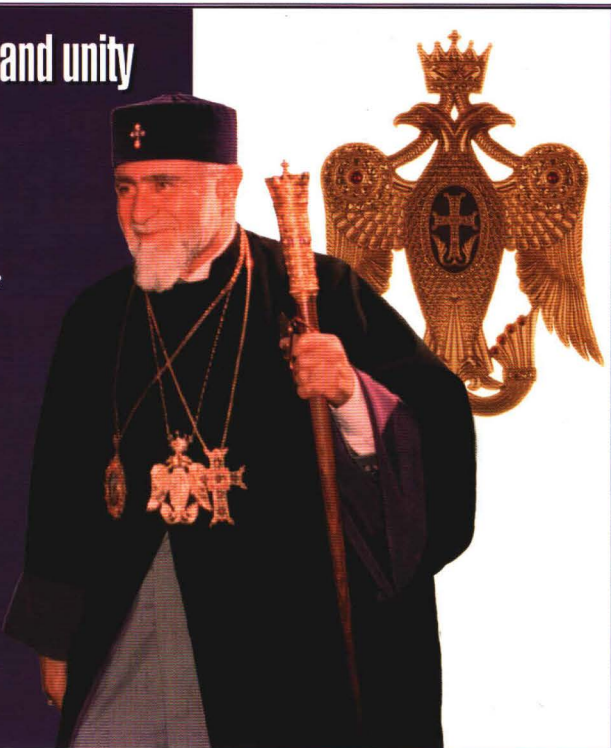


Love, prayer and unity
