Dear President Clinton:

As the Primate of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America, I have the distinct pleasure to inform you that the newly-elected global pontiff of the Armenian Church, His Holiness Karekin I, Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians will be visiting North America from January 10 through January 22, 1996.

This pontifical visit—His Holiness' first visit to our Dioceses in the United States—will be a major event for thousands of Armenians and non-Armenians as well. His visit to our Diocese, scheduled at the dawn of the New Year, will have a great impact on the nearly one million Armenians living in the United States, and will be of considerable importance as well for the Republic of Armenia. As we approach a new millennium and the 1700th anniversary of Christianity for the Armenian people, His Holiness' visit will focus on A New Era—Church, Youth, Community.

We are currently planning many visits and meetings for the Catholicos while he is in our country and certainly would be most honored if he could visit with you at the White House. During previous visits of our pontiffs, they have been received by Presidents Carter, Reagan, and Bush. His Holiness is eager to meet with you, to express his personal gratitude—and that of the citizens of the Republic of Armenia—for the humanitarian aid which the United States has continually provided since the devastating earthquake of 1988.

He also wishes to express his deep gratitude to the people of this blessed nation of the United States of America, for the example of hope it represents to all the Armenian people throughout the world.

Mr. President we would be greatly honored if you could arrange to meet with His Holiness during his stay in this country. He is scheduled to arrive at New York's JFK Airport on January 10, 1996, and his itinerary will bring him to Washington, D.C. on January 15-16. Naturally, we would be more than happy to arrange his schedule to your convenience.

In closing, I wish to express the collective thanks of all our faithful to you Mr. President for your friendship to the Armenian people and for the support you have offered into the building of a new nation from the rubble of a political system that retarded growth and prosperity for some seventy years.
