SUBJECT: Assignment of Permanent Priest to St. Paul's Parish

Your Grace:

Over the past four (4) years, St. Paul's Parish Council has formally requested your consideration in assigning its parish a permanent clergyman.

Pursuant to your advise during past visits to our parish and other occasional meetings, we have continually strived to align our church organ-izations and operating structure in accordance with Diocesan by laws and procedures as expressed by you.

Specifically, in our quest for an appropriate priest as you quoted during the summer of 1974 visit to our parish, "consideration to a permanent priest when available could be made only to those parishes who meet the needs not only in spiritual — parish growth and financial stability but display an aggressive pursuit for a priest".

To assist in the financial stability category our parish established a Pastoral Fund which has dwelled to a minimum goal of \$20,000 which we established in consonance with your advise as a necessity to meet a major milestone in solidifying our position in continued request for a parish priest.

In further pursuit of this goal, we anticipate a visit to New York for the expressed purpose to discuss this matter and request an audience with you to discuss the ramifications, supporting data and goals we have set constituting our basis for this request.

At this time, we ask your consideration to discuss this matter during the 19th or 26th of March. If neither date is appropriate, please advise the date and time which is most convenient to you.
