1. The Springfield parish wishes to purchase 6.4 acres of land as the beginning of a program to build a new church. The parish's current facilities are deemed inadequate. The attached building committee report contains the necessary details.

2. The St. Mary parish wishes to purchase a plot of land, 3.9 acres, in Livingston, New Jersey, with a church, hall and house already on it. The cost will be \$325,000. The parish feels this will answer their needs more effectively than the building program they had originally planned. The parish has \$130,000 and a current property worth \$85,000, which will leave the parish with a total obligation of \$110,000.
