SUMMARY OF DECISIONS

Diocesan Council Meeting Held on Friday, December 10, 1976

- 1. The letter received from Michael Haratunian, Chairman of the Unity Committee of the Separated Brethren, will be considered by the five members of the appointed By-Laws Committee who are on the Diocesan Council. Father Dajad Davidian will be the convener. Meeting should take place before the end of December 1976.
- 2. Father Zaven Arzoumanian, Father Arshen Aivazian, Father Carnig Hallajian, Bedros Norehad and Berj Yeretzian were appointed to write, as soon as possible, a position paper on the Unity question.
- 3. The publication of a bi-monthly "Center News" was approved. Budget \$13,000 per year.
- 4. Primate's stipend to be raised to \$20,000 plus \$2,000 for any and all expenses involving the Primate's activities in the Diocese. The Vicar General's stipend to be \$7,000 and the Director's \$18,000.
- 5. Pension Plan: That all priests be advised in writing that due to a miscalculation in the past 15 months, an additional sum is owing to the Diocese.
- 6. As of the January 1977 billing, three per cent can be added to the parish assessments with a note informing parishes of the three per cent discount for prompt monthly responses.

- b. Number of dues paying members in good standing as of June 13, 1976.
- c. In order to be a voting member of good standing, one must be a member six months prior to the election date (see Article 7 of the By-Laws.)
 - d. To be eligible to hold office a member must have been a member one year prior to the 1977 election.
 - e. To appoint one or two representatives from the Diocese at the Elberon meeting on February 20, 1977. Recommended names: Bishop Papken Varjabedian, Father Carnig Hallajian and George Mekenian.
- 8. The election of the three members of the Choir Central Council was approved.
- 9. Mr. Alex Manoogian's letter. The Diocesan Council would like to meet with Mr. Manoogian.
- 10. St. Vartanantz Church of Lowell, Massachusetts, was granted permission to build the new church building.
- 11. The Diocesan Council approved the list of the resident clergy of the Diocese, as presented by Father Dajad, who are not delegates to the Diocesan Assembly.
