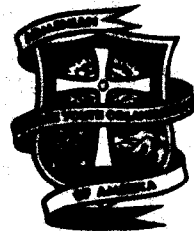

1) ACYOA ALumni

A committee comprised of former members of the ACYOA established for the purpose of initiating an aggressive fund-raising campaign to finance new ACYOA programs.

2) ACYOA College Connection

A committee that will develop ways of reaching out to Armenian college students by means of sponsoring religious, educational, cultural and social activities for students on their campuses.

3) ACYOA Public Relations Committee

A committee that will generate a high sense of spirit and enthusiasm for the national programming of ACYOA. A principal focus for this committee would be the promotion of the ACYOA Sports Weekend on a North American scale.

4) ACYOA Cultural Committee

A committee that will divide itself into regional committees with the purpose of promoting ACYOA sponsored cultural programs throughout the Diocese. This committee would stay abreast of current activities and development regarding Genocide recognition.

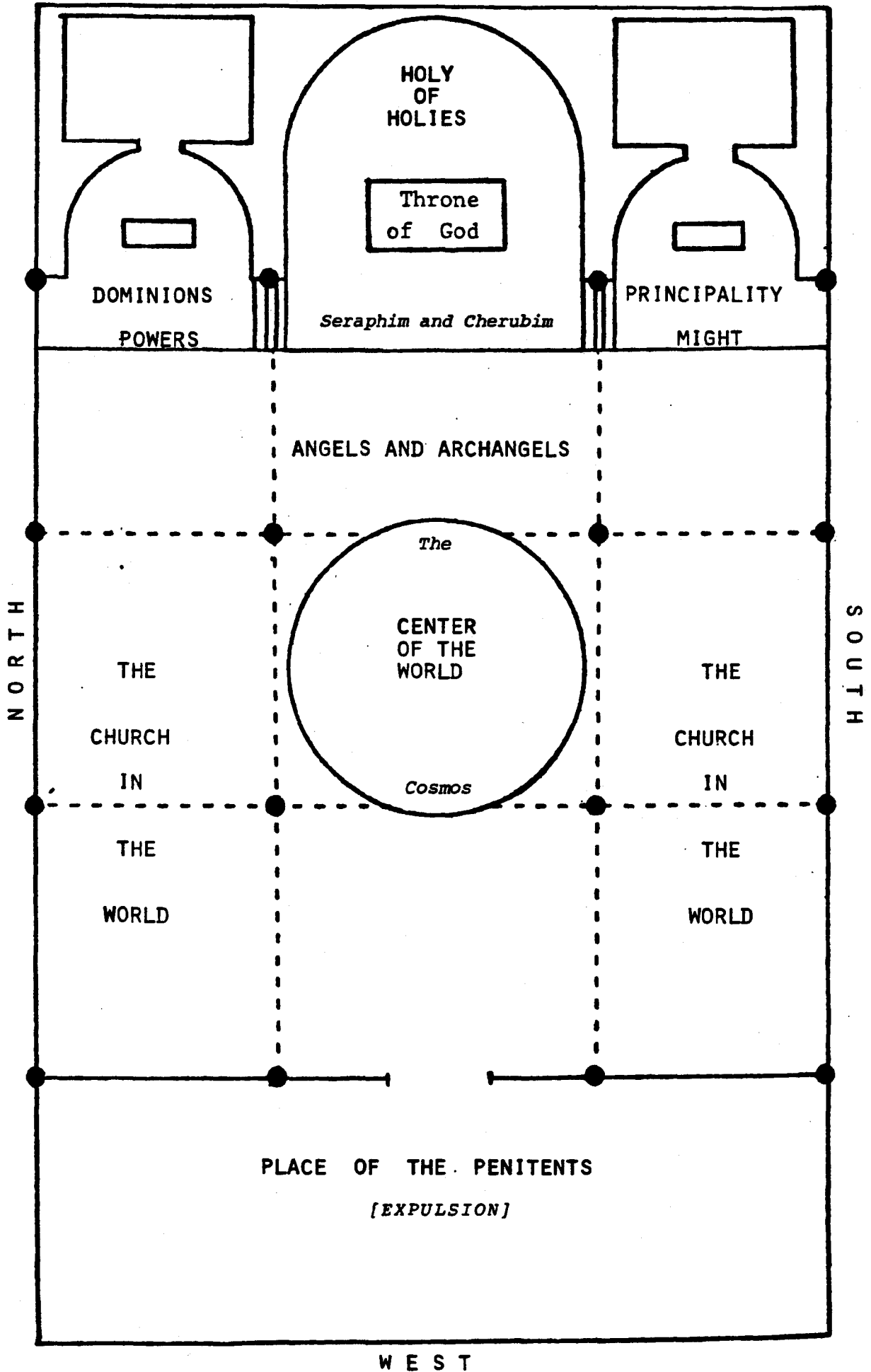

SYMBOLISM IN THE ARMENIAN CHURCH: Part One:

"The Church as the Temple of our Faith"

- Length of time: 28 mins. (approximately)
- # of slides: 88
- Type of tape: Cassette
- Viewer age: High School through adult. Serious subject - abstract concepts.
- Theme: Church building as a functional house of worship.
- Purpose: To acquaint the viewer with the various symbols and symbolism incorporated in the Armenian Church, thereby allowing for more meaningful participation and understanding during worship.
- Specific: This program deals with symbolism in terms of space and layout of the church building. The meanings of the various "places" in the church, the setup, the purpose, etc. This understanding will assist the viewer in a practical way with regard to the Services of the Church.
- Series: This program is the first in a series of programs dealing with symbolism in the Armenian Church. Other programs will include vessels, vestments, gestures, ritual, liturgical order and customs. Although the other programs may not need to be shown in any particular order, this first program will assist in an underlying base from which a more complete understanding of the Services and liturgics of the Armenian Church may follow. It is suggested that this program precede the others.
- Format: This program has a slide-tape format. The slides are changed according to a set script, which should be followed as closely as possible. The music-narration should be loud and powerful, especially in the beginning to capture the attention of the audience. It is suggested that the introduction be read by a knowledgeable person as an orientation into the topic. The room for showing should be as dark as possible. It is highly suggested that the operator preview the program before formal showing.
- Needs: Slide projector, tape cassette player, screen, public-address system or some type of amplification system if possible.

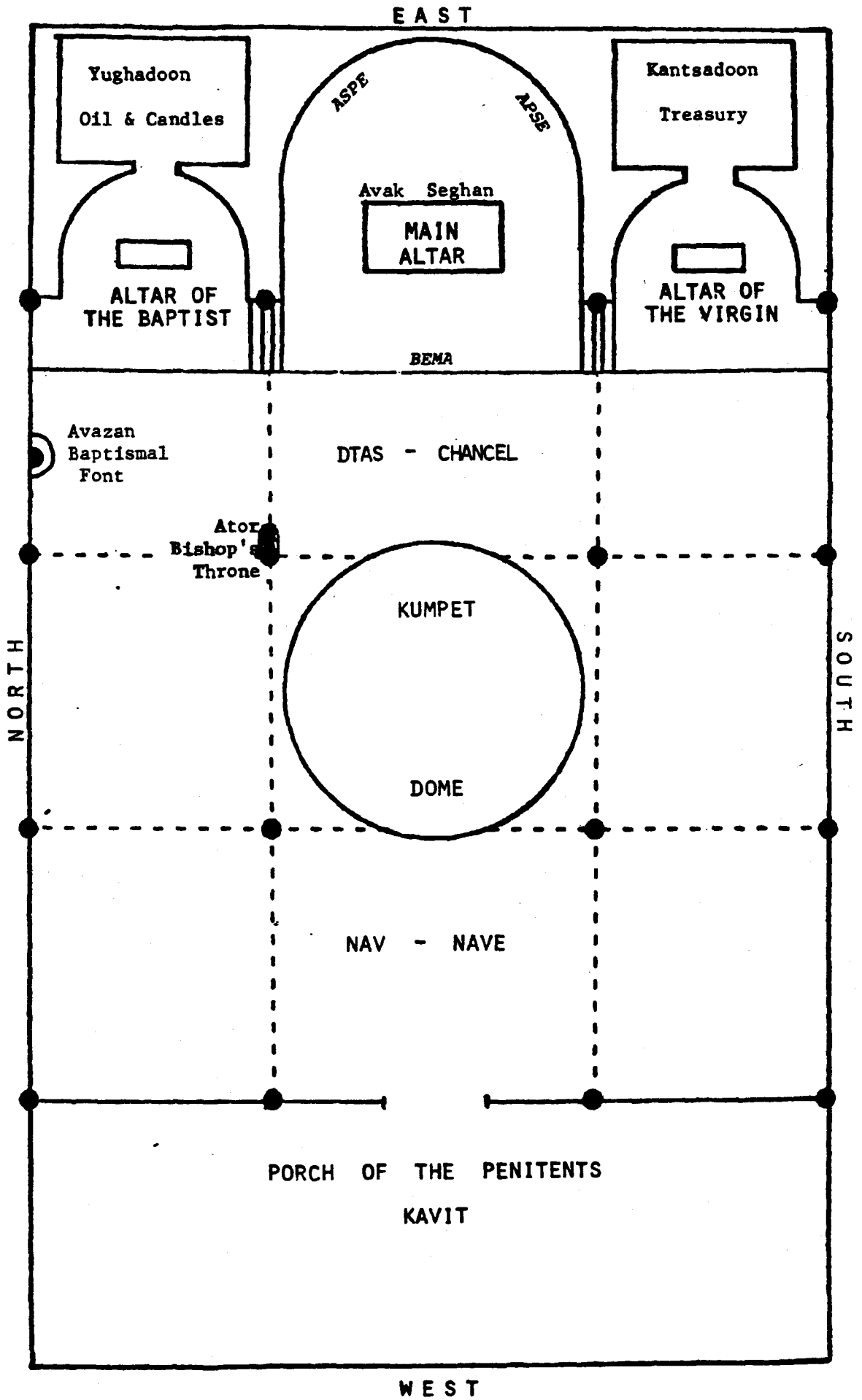
