more about the play and discussed it with other
young adults, and I feel it might be a nucleus
for a Martyrs program on Saturday night, April
23rd, at the Diocese. We would add other
speakers, performers, etc. I think the theme
of the play will move Armenians of all ages,
even though the protagonists are teenagers.
I would like ACYOA SRS. to sponsor the program.

A group from Bayside ACYOA has approached me
to produce the play, Godspell, in the fall of
1988. They have actors and production experience,
and they would be interested in Jan's play.
I discussed this with them at my meeting with
them on January 10th.

I think ACYOA should be taking the lead in
encouraging young people to develop their
artistic talents.
